Attention 8<sup>th</sup> grade girls: High School volleyball workout schedules are in the office.



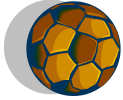
Attention 8th Grade boys playing high school soccer next year. There will be a call out meeting in Mr. Nuss's room after school on Friday May 30th.
